Boat Club Workday Jobs 11/30/23

Remove all the dead brush/leaves and other debris on the property. Dispose of in the burn pile.

Brush down the cobwebs on all sides of the clubhouse and out buildings outside walls and the Port Captains residence. (Don't touch the bird's nests).

Paint the log bumpers all around the club property including into the burn pile area. There are some not yet painted by the burn pile.

Remove and install new linoleum in the women's restroom. (On hold until further notice)

Touch up paint under eves on north side of the Port Captain's house. (This is a 2 person job for safety reasons.)

Scrub and rinse the bench on the guest dock.

Scrub and rinse all the BBQ tables around the club property.

Trim all the growth going over the log bumpers around the club property that is in the way of walking or parking and dispose of in the burn pile.

Remove and clean the drip pans under the tractor and place fresh cat litter in the pan. There is a bag of litter in the garage.

Pressurewash the tractor garage floor.

Police the entire club property for mislaid wood or metal. Remove to the storage area behind the dumpsters. This includes any lumber scrapes or metal that has no purpose where you find it.

Pressurewash the boat ramp. This should be timed so the tide is out as to expose more slime that needs to be removed. Check the tide table for maximum exposure.

Install some rain gutter on the clubhouse roof above where the septic tanks are located. Install downspouts to avoid water reaching the septic tank access panels. Contact the work day chairs to determine how much gutter and where to route the downspouts.

Paint the rain gutters/downspouts on the west side of the tractor garage. Use the new gallon of "dark brown paint" found in the paint cabinet marked "rain gutters" in the garage that matches the house trim.

Re-plumb the kitchen sink drain and men's room sink to drain into the septic tank. Contact Sam or Mike for details.

Pressurewash both main and guest docks.

Sort thru the containers of nuts, bolts and assorted fasteners found in the garage and repackage them in the provided clear plastic tubs also located on the bench in the garage.

Spray the provided "Home Defense" bug spray located in the garage. Concentrate on the perimeter of the floor, under the benches/shelving and behind any obstacles. Use liberally! Spray only the inside of the garage and the tractor garage.

Use the new leaf blower to round up all debris/leaves around the property and move to the burn pile.

Finish painting the deck ceiling with the same color paint as the clubhouse. This can be located in the garage in a 5 gallon container (marked "clubhouse exterior).

Contact Sam Bobb for clarification if needed for this job.

Apply the "hazard tape strip" to the threshold of the clubhouse door. It will be located in the paint supply cabinet in the garage

Install a new GFI outlet in the box supplying the stored boats. One can be found in the garage marked for this project.
